



MAIL THEFT ALERT FOR THE AREA OF TRUCKEE, CA

This notice is to inform postal customers that this office has received multiple reports of possible mail theft activity in Truckee, CA. These reports include thefts from blue United States Postal Service collection boxes and residential curbside mailboxes.

If you believe you had mail that was stolen, please complete the complaint form on the reverse of this notice and mail it to us at the address shown below and we will enter you into our database as a possible mail theft victim *and issue you an individual report number.* You should keep both a copy of this notice and the subsequent report number we send you for your records. If outgoing checks were stolen, it is recommended that you attempt to verify that they have been properly received/cashed. **If checks have been altered or forged, and cashed, we need you to provide us with copies for investigative purposes.** **If credit cards/accounts have been misused, we also need copies of the bills with those charges marked.** You should also file a report with your local police or sheriff's office if your financial information is misused as a result of this theft. It is also suggested that you contact a credit reporting agency such as Experian, Equifax or TransUnion and run your credit report now and again in two or three months to make sure no new accounts have been opened, or addresses changed on existing accounts.
